Part 1: Level 1 Prerequisite Check

I understand the principles of ionising radiation and justification criteria

Including IRMER 2017 requirements for dental CBCT imaging.



I can identify the basic anatomical structures visible on a CBCT scan

Teeth, alveolar bone, maxillary sinuses, inferior dental canal, mental foramen.



I have hands-on experience viewing CBCT datasets

Including scrolling through axial, coronal and sagittal planes.



I understand the difference between 2D and 3D radiographic interpretation

Including why CBCT findings cannot always be inferred from OPG alone.

WHAT EVERY REPORT MUST CONTAIN

Part 2: The 7 Elements of a Defensible CBCT Report



1. Patient identification and date of examination



2. Clinical indication and justification for the scan

Why CBCT was the most appropriate imaging modality for this patient.



3. Technical parameters

Field of view, voxel size, exposure settings — relevant to diagnostic quality.



4. Systematic description of findings
